

# Provisory goals for a radically friendly economy

*A friendly and honest global economy gets realised bit by bit, every time a step is taken in the direction of, among others, the following ideals and principles. Only by striving towards the ultimate ideal will we find out what is the best possible world...*

- ☆ Fulfillment of all basic needs of all people
- ☆ No one harms anyone, be it a human living in a distant continent or future, oneself, or be it an (other) animal.
- ☆ Some ways to obtain this:
  - ☆ General, worldwide and total disconnection between labour and access to means of existence.
  - ☆ General material soberness, in order to enable a fair, thus roughly equal distribution of materials and services for everyone.
  - ☆ Abolition of private property of means of production and any property that is important to life.
  - ☆ All people decide about everything that relates to issues of means of existence and production. Abolition of dictatorship in companies (and other regions of 'democracies'). The only way all people can truly decide is discussing in small-scale groups, be they affinity-, neighbourhood- or workplacegroups. Via confederative delegation, views can be communicated among in principle infinitely many small-scale groups.
  - ☆ Instead of delimiting worldwide mutual understanding and agreement by deciding 'democratically', all decisions should in principle be made only after everyone wholeheartedly agrees. In the long run, global and local unfairness, frustration and conflict will decrease and the quality of decisions will increase. No argument should be neglected under the excuse that it is not yet agreed upon by the majority (or, as in present day global society, by an a global elite).
  - ☆ Money, although unnecessary, should be used as means of exchange only. Abolition of all forms of interest, dividend etcetera. Interest causes flows of wealth going from poor to rich instead of the other way around. Interest also 'forces' people to act according to short-term aims, and thus to long-term destruction of all life.
